The Lies that Feed the Northern Territory Intervention continues the work of Aboriginal affairs journalist Chris Graham, in exposing the media's role in the Northern Territory intervention, by far the largest human rights abuse in Australia in living memory. Graham looks back at the original promises by the Howard government, set against what was delivered. He also looks at why the government was able to get away with it.... Because of lazy media reporting. The talk finishes with a discussion about a new form of journalism – Agenda journalism – through new Aboriginal affairs publication, Tracker magazine. Tracker seeks to hold governments and media to account by doing more than just reporting.

Chris Graham is the founding and former editor of the National Indigenous Times, and recently launched Tracker magazine, a monthly publication through the NSW Aboriginal Land Council. He has won a Walkley Award and a Walkley High Commendation for his Indigenous affairs reporting, and has twice won the Australian Human Rights Award – Print Category. Chris lives in Sydney, and in addition to his role at Tracker, he is also the Director of Media & Marketing for the NSW Aboriginal Land Council.
