Julie is a senior researcher for the Department of History, University of Sydney. She works on an ongoing project [www.historyofaboriginalsydney.edu](http://www.historyofaboriginalsydney.edu). This project is lead by Professor Peter Read. It is a website to repatriate knowledge in an Indigenous context. It reveals histories, pictures, stories and family connections for Aboriginal people in Sydney.

Julie's humour, her storytelling and her passion for Aboriginal people will make it a night you won't forget.

Julie Janson also works as a playwright, screenwriter, producer, script editor in Sydney and internationally. Julie's awards include a Highly Commended Human Rights Award for the play she produced, 'Gunjies', which was also nominated for an AWGIE (Australian Writers' Guild annual awards). Her recent play, 'The Crocodile Hotel', was short-listed for the Patrick White Award.
