

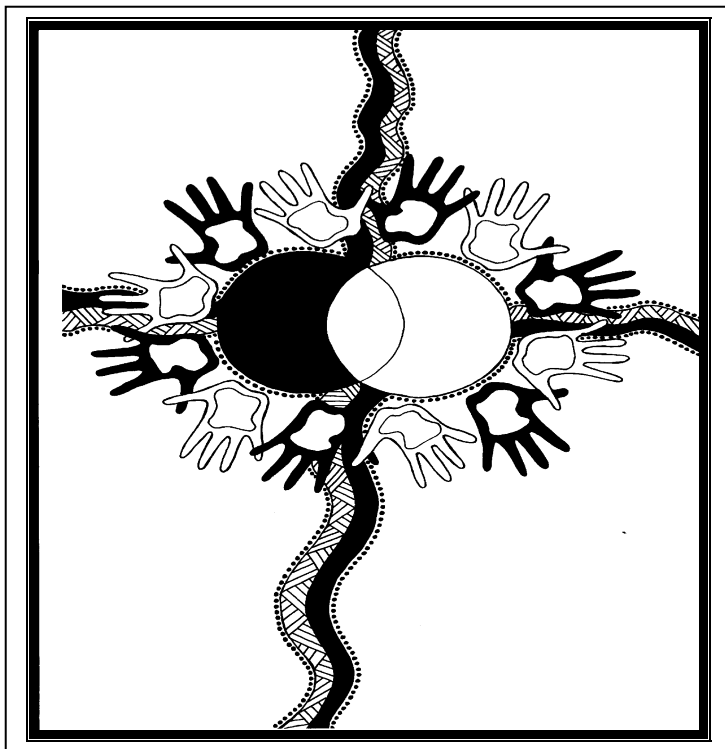
# Sorry Day 2008
