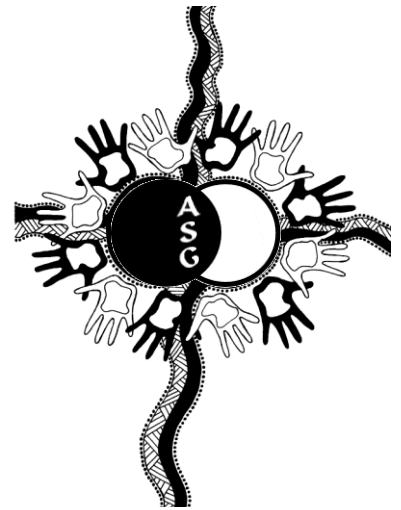


SORRY DAY
